This seat was vacant due to the resignation of Mrs. Judy Schroedl, who wanted to work more closely with students in a non- Board role. This position had been posted three times before Mr. Goldman applied. Mr. Carter interviewed Mr. Goldman at Model Creek School on July 24th. Superintendent Carter then spoke individually with the administration, Governing Board Members, and several community members prior to making the appointment.

Mr. Goldman has been a resident of the district since 2005, living in Peeples Valley. He is a widower with grown children and grandchildren.

Mr. Goldman graduated from Lawndale High School in California. He attended El Camino College, prior to entering the printing business, working for TRW in various aspects of the industry including supervisory positions, for thirty five (35) years.

Mr. Goldman retired in 2000. Since that time, he has served as the President of the Chamber of Commerce. He was also elected by the voters and served a full term on the Peeples Valley Fire District.
