To be eligible to hold this seat a person must; be a registered voter (yet this office is considered non-partisan), be a citizen of the United States of America, be at least 18 years of age, possess their civil rights, have continually resided within the school district for at least one year immediately preceding taking office, and the candidate or their spouse cannot be employed by the district.

Deadline for receipt of letters of interest is Friday, June 28, 2013, at 5:00 p.m. Mr. Carter will interview finalists at the COCSO District Office on Monday, July 1, 2013, and if needed, on July 3, 2013. The appointment should be announced by Monday, July 8, 2013 and be valid through December 31, 2014.
