Yavapai County School Superintendent Tim Carter is pleased to announce the appointment of **Mrs. Lucy Gaviglia to the Bagdad Unified School District Governing Board**. The appointment was effective Thursday, July 2, 2015 and will conclude on December 31, 2016. The vacancy was created by the resignation of Board Member Kristi Maciejewski, who moved out of the District. The service provided to the District by Ms. Maciejewski is greatly appreciated.

Mrs. Gaviglia graduated from Chinle High School and attended Yavapai College. She has been employed by Basha's for 23 years. She worked as a cashier at the Basha's Grocery in Eager, before transferring to the Bagdad store five (5) years ago, where she currently serves as the scan coordinator. In addition to other family members, she has a son who currently attends Bagdad High School.

Mr. Carter posted this position twice. The first posting resulted in only one candidate. In an effort to identify additional candidates, the position was reposted. Mr. Carter received one letter of interest and conducted an interview in Bagdad on Tuesday, June 9, 2015. Prior to making the appointment, he spoke with each currently seated Governing Board Member and Administrative Leaders to receive their feedback. Mr. Carter was contacted by community members who offered their insights into the appointment as well. "I appreciate members of the community speaking with me about the vacancy", Carter said.

Superintendent Carter stated that "Mrs. Gaviglia is familiar with the community and the operations of the school district. She is a solid proponent of public education, has attended several

Governing Board meetings, and should be a resource to her fellow Board Members. I believe she will represent the voters of the Bagdad School District very well. Her experience as a parent will be a benefit as she carries out her new responsibilities”.
