DECLARATION BY THE YAVAPAI COUNTY SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT OF THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTIONS HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES §15-426(B).
