

ARPA Yavapai County Broadband Project Question and Answers as of 5.18.22

Q.1 5.18.22 Will any of the broadband work that Yavapai County will be doing extend into other counties (Maricopa, for example)?

No. These dollars are intended to provide services to Yavapai County residents in unincorporated areas that are unserved or underserved. However, one of our vendors, could work directly with residents in another county, as a private party, and that property might be adjacent to a Yavapai County boundary. The company could also decide to “extend their line” beyond our contract, within the county boundary using their own funds, since they are already in the area and it would create a win-win situation. We refer to that as “leveraging”, and it benefits everyone. The company may also have an opportunity to partner with municipalities whose city limits may extend into other counties.
